

In order to comply with the guidelines issued by the Securities and Futures Commission (SFC) on cybersecurity management, we will be expected to progressively launch “two-factor authentication” for account login on 21 April 2018. Customers can enjoy a secure, reliable and convenient internet trading experience.

### Step of registering two factor authentication

- Futures trading system – SP Trade must be upgraded to version 8.75.9 or later.
- The one time password will be sent to the designated email address
- Enter the one time password within 5 minutes to complete the registration for this device.
- Login name and password are required only when using the same device in the future. The maximum 5 devices can be registered only.
